CONTENTS AND DAMAGE

Upon receipt of your item(s) verify the packing list and contents are correct, report any discrepancy immediately to Assembled Products® Corporation at (800) 548-3373. Additionally, inspect the contents of the carton for any visible damage. If damage has occurred immediately file a claim with the carrier and immediately notify Assembled Products Corporation at (800) 548-3373.

ATTENTION

It is the responsibility of the owner of this Motor Dolly to maintain it in a safe and reliable operating condition at all times.

LIMITED WARRANTY

- **Warranty** - One year (1) from date of shipping, except for battery.
- **Battery** - Six months (6) from date of shipment. Replacement batteries also carry a six (6) months warranty. **Note:** User is required to provide the Motor Dolly hand truck serial number and charge the battery for a minimum of 24 hours to verify condition before a replacement can be approved.
- **Parts-Limited Warranty** - All parts are warranted by the manufacturer to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of one year from date of shipment. **Please Note:** Inline fuses may require replacement under normal operating conditions and **DO NOT** constitute a defect in material or workmanship. This warranty does not include wear and tear caused by above normal usage, abuse, negligence, freight damage, or damage caused by improper use or care, or by outside sources such as fire, floods, etc. If component has failed due to a defect in material or workmanship, it will be replaced or repaired at the manufacturer's discretion at no charge to the owner.
- **Labor** - The manufacturer will cover labor charges for work performed in the field for six-months from the date of shipment as a result of defect in materials and workmanship. Charges incurred for replacing the inline fuses are exempt. Please follow all troubleshooting instructions prior to requesting service. Double service calls due to improper first call service or lack of repair parts are exempt.
- Shipping, handling, or travel expenses incurred for the repair of unit or parts as well as for items worn out through normal use whose malfunction is not attributable to defect are excluded.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNINGS

- Never use the power-assist to move a load heavier than you are safely able to move and control under unpowered conditions. The Motor Dolly hand trucks are designed to reduce operator fatigue, reduce operator injuries, and increase operator efficiency, **NOT** to increase load capacity or handling abilities.
- The operator must be fully capable of operating the power assist hand truck safely.
- Never use power-assist in the Motor Dolly convertible hand truck two-wheel position.
- Never operate on surfaces with impaired traction, such as on sand and sloped surfaces that might be slippery due to water, ice, or other conditions.
- Never transport unstable or loosely packed loads.
- Never place any part of your body under the Motor Dolly or near moving parts.
- Never ride on or transport passengers.
- Never use the Motor Dolly hand truck in water over ½" deep to prevent loss of traction.
- Always make sure the Motor Dolly path is clear of persons and hazards during use.
- Always operate the Motor Dolly at safe speeds dependent on operating conditions including operator's abilities, load size, inclines, slippery surfaces, and around people.
- Always avoid sharp turns.
- Always travel up and down the slope of an incline, never traverse sideways across an incline.
- Always operate slowly while on inclines.
- Never leave the Motor Dolly hand truck unattended on an incline. The unit will roll. Always make sure the load is within the specified weight limits.
- Always make sure the load is properly secured and evenly distributed.
- Always wear skid-proof, safety shoes when operating.
- Always turn the main power **OFF** when not in use.
- Always load and unload with the Motor Dolly hand truck on a level surface.
- Always turn the main power **OFF** when loading or unloading.
- Always turn the main power **OFF** when on a lift gate.
- Make sure combined weight of operator, Motor Dolly hand truck, and load does not exceed the weight limit of any ramp or lift used.
